RESOLUTION

Sub:—Reconstitution of the Copyright Enforcement Advisory Council.

No. F. 7-4/2003-IC—Consequent on expiry of the term of the Copyright Enforcement Advisory Council, the Government of India has decided to reconstitute the Council for a period of three years with effect from 12th August, 2009 with the following composition and functions :—

2. FUNCTIONS OF THE COUNCIL

The functions of the Copyright Enforcement Advisory Council will be :—

- (i) to review the progress of enforcement of the Copyright Act periodically; and
- (ii) to advise the Government regarding measures for improving the enforcement of the Copyright Act.

3. HEADQUARTERS AND SECRETARIAT OF THE COUNCIL

The Headquarters of the Council will be at New Delhi and its Secretariat will be provided by the Book Promotion & Copyright Division in the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development.

4. COMPOSITION OF THE COUNCIL

The Copyright Enforcement Advisory Council will have the following composition :—

5. TENURE OF MEMBERS

The term of the Copyright Enforcement Advisory Council will be three years. The tenure of the members of the Council, other than ex-officio members, will be three years unless a shorter or longer term is indicated. Where a member of the Council becomes a member by reason of the office or appointment he holds, his membership of the Council will terminate when he ceases to hold that office on appointment.

6. MEETINGS AND SUB-COMMITTEES

The Council will meet at least once every six months. The Council may set up Committees/Panels for specific purposes which may meet as frequently as required.

ORDER

Ordered that a copy of the Resolution be communicated to all the State Governments and Administrations of Union Territories, all Ministries of the Government of India and their Departments, President's Secretariat, Lok Sabha Secretariat, Rajya Sabha Secretariat, Cabinet Secretariat, Prime Minister Office, Department of Parliamentary Affairs, Planning Commission.

Ordered also that the Resolution be published in the Gazette of India for information.
