I.A.1168 /2026 (Exemption)

1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking exemption from filing certified copies of annexures and illegible documents with proper margin at this stage.
2. The clear and typed/translated copies of the documents with proper margins of the dim annexures be filed within six weeks with an advance copy to the defendants.
3. The application stands disposed of.

They seek and are granted four weeks' time to file reply with an advance copy to the learned counsel for the plaintiff. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed by the petitioner within four weeks thereafter with an advance copy to learned counsel for the defendants.
